## 2016 -2017 Ohio School Entry Immunization Requirement for TDAP and Meningococcal

Starting with the 2016-2017 school year, all incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grade and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students in Ohio must have proof that they have the age-appropriate meningococcal vaccine.

- Students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade are required to have at least one dose of the **meningococcal** and **Tdap** vaccine prior to school entry.
- Students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade must have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine, with a minimum interval between 8 weeks prior to entry. If the first dose of meningococcal vaccine was administered after the 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, a second dose is not required.
