SCHEDULE

Bellefontaine High School is on a modified block schedule. The day consists of a combination of 40-minute periods and 80-minute double periods, or blocks. Most academic classes meet for one semester 80-minute block or one yearlong 40-minute period.

There are three six-week grading periods per semester for all classes. Advanced Placement (AP) and College Credit Plus (CCP) courses are weighted by adding .03125 to the cumulative GPA. All courses are included in the GPA and class rank.
